**Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11 Ephesians 1:17-23 Matthew 28:16-20**

“The readings for today’s celebration of the Ascension of the Lord once again remind us that as Christians we are people of hope. In the second reading Saint Paul eloquently exhorts the Ephesians to enlighten their hearts so that they will know the hope and glory that come from being people who place their trust in the Lord Jesus. Finally, in the Gospel, the Lord lets the disciples know that their mission is to spread the hope of the gospel to all the nations.”
